The Administration would like to inform relevant parties concerned, of an error on Certificates of Civil Liability (CLC) issued for Gibraltar registered ships during the last quarter of 2018, and first quarter of 2019.

The error centres on an erroneous statement referring to CLC's being issued in electronic format. Currently, CLC documentation is issued incorporating an electronic signature, but does not constitute as electronic certification. The erroneous statement has since been removed. CLC's do however incorporate a unique issuing / tracking number, which may be referred to, should verification of authenticity be required from the Administration.

It is imperative to note, that CLC documentation should be maintained in its original format on board Gibraltar registered ships.

In way of rectification, the Administration has re-issued all affected certificates, which shall be forwarded to respective parties at no additional cost.

In the interim period, a copy of this Notice should be retained on board Gibraltar registered ships to which any CLC applies, and made available for reference to any attending Authority should the need arise.
